Its standard DVD. Plays in any DVD software like PowerDVD, WinDVD, or a hardware/console player. PC requires mpeg2 decoder.

The tests are EEG of brain to determine injury, EMG of nerve impulses of muscle tissue to see damage, and MRI of hopefully core muscles to check for muscle damage. The MRI is not absolute, but the other two are being recommended.
